

Town of Farmingdale Select Board Meeting Minutes
February 21, 2018

Members Present: Wayne Kilgore--Nancy Frost

Others Present: Rose Webster – Alden Longfellow – Dan Longfellow-Tony Barry- Mike LaPlante

Meeting opened by Nancy Frost 6:30 p.m. with Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes had not been reviewed, no motion made.

Three bids were received for the Architectural/Engineering Contract for the new Fire Station;

CES Inc. – Brewer Maine - \$120,000.00

AE Hodson – Waterville Maine - \$39,225.00 -this did not include the pricing on the construction phase

Port City – Portland Maine- \$49,000 – plus direct reimbursable and permitting fees estimated \$7,500.00

The Selectboard will have a workshop next week – February 28th at 5:00pm to review and discuss the 3 bids received.

There was a discussion with Tony Barry regarding adding the snow removal – shoveling of the Pump Stations to his current contract. The Selectboard can review if it more feasible and cost effective to have them perform the work and remove from the upcoming Winter Maintenance Contract. Tony gave the Selectboard some pricing options for their review.

There was a discussion with Alden Longfellow to see if he would be interested in adding removing snow/ice and opening the catch basins when requested by the Selectboard to his contract when heavy rains may cause problems with flooding. Alden said that he would work something up and also would like to make a report on the issues with catch basins and cross culverts that are in need of repair.

Wayne Kilgore said that the asbestos removal is almost complete on the property that was purchased for the new Fire Station.

RJD Assessing Agent will meet with the Board at the next Selectboard Meeting to review extending their contract. Rose will have a list of Foreclosures and property that should go out to bid for the next meeting. She provided the Board with one property that should be put out to bid soon and will also forward the information onto Jim Grant.

Mike LaPlante said that he was going to resign the 911 Coordinator in July. That he has someone in mind that he thinks would be good at keeping the updated with GIS and changes as needed. Mike has also set up a time with Hallowell Fire Department on Sunday so that the members of the new fire station committee can go look at how the building of Hallowell's new station is doing.
