F.R.A.C. Meeting Minutes

November 17, 2016

The Farmingdale Road Advisory Committee (F.R.A.C.) met on Thursday November 17, 2016 following the Farmingdale Sewer Committee meeting at the Farmingdale Town Office.

Ben called the meeting to order at the close of the Sewer Committee Meeting at 7:16pm

The minutes of 9/22/2016 were approved.

Discussion: Paving Northern Ave will be done in the spring. Paving on Northern Ave is part of much larger project that is re-building a section of road. Projects for Northern as well as Hayford Heights were discussed.

Conclusion or Action to be taken: Coffin Engineering will write up the scope of work for these projects. We would like to have pre bid shortly after the first of the year so that contracts can be awarded by the first part of April. As soon as the snow is gone the contractors can begin their work. If there is any money left we will use it on some other paving that is needed. Storm Drains Ditching and Paving will all be taken care of by the Coffin work.

Discussion: Bill Rogers would like to have a company like Brownies Landscaping and do some chipping as well as the shoulders on the whole Outlet Road. This will be a spring project.

Discussion: There was discussion about catch basins and storm drains.

Conclusion or Action to be taken: The Hayford Heights project would cover some of these catch basins in that area. There are still some streets in the Hayford Height are and Hasson Street that have some significant issues that will need to be addressed.

Discussion: There was discussion on the manholes that are in need of repair and the contract that we would like to use for these manholes.

Conclusion or Action to be taken: Ben will take a look at the contract that was written by Dirigo and see if he can adjust it to fit our needs. If he can make changes he will edit and send out for everyone to review.

Discussion: Ben spoke to say that in January once we get the figures as to what the cost will be for Hayford Heights that we will need to sit down and figure out our budget so that we know what we will have money for. We should have some figures ready for our February meeting also would like the road commissioner at this meeting.

Discussion: Out by Bill Rogers house beavers have blocked up a culvert

Conclusion or Action to be taken: Greg Smith will be removing the beavers. FRAC will be receiving an invoice for the removal of the beavers.
