Mark Pelkey Road Commissioner – parking notices were passed out before the storm and this worked very well. There was a car parked at the Bowman Street pump station for over a week that had to get towed since the owner did not come to remove the vehicle. We will purchase signs “No Parking will be towed at owners’ expense” and put them on the pump stations.

It is still very cold out so nothing is melting at this time and there are bad spots in the shaded areas on the roads. Hagar will need to come back in the Spring to fix a hump on Park Street. There is also another section on the corner of Easy and Park that will need to be looked at when the ice melts away.

Town Truck is in good shape and ready to go.

Doug – The Select Board will attempt to cut \$300,000 to \$400,000 out of the budget by getting paving done in the Spring. Mark is looking over the contract so that we can get the paving RFP out next month. We are thinking of paving the tree streets which are the smaller roads in the Hayford Heights. When we do the bigger streets that will need catch basin replacement that will be a separate item.
