The Farmingdale Sewer Committee met on February 7, 2024 at the Farmingdale Town Office.

Eben called the Sewer Committee meeting to order on 2/7/2024 at 6:00pm.

Vortex – Have not received monthly reports from Vortex (*Natalie will contact Adam from Vortex and ask again for the reports and will also hold back payment until we have received our reports that are due to us. Natalie will send an update when 39 Meadow Hill Drive has been completed.*

- + Eben made a motion to approve the abatement for Austin, Fusaro, Skehan and Kennebec Savings Bank.

- + Vote 3-0-0

DOT will be paving a portion of Maine Ave. and we will need to either adjust our manholes to their specification or have a contract with DOT and allow them to adjust the manholes. We have 24 manholes and the quote is for \$2,300.00 per manhole it would cost the town approximately \$55,200.00. If DOT takes care of this the liability will then fall on them if something goes wrong.

- + Eben made a motion to choose the Standard approach and allow DOT to take care of the manholes that will be affected by the paving that will be done in 2024.

- + Vote 3-0-0

The sewer committee received the current budget to review. We should be able to carry forward some amounts from the Sewer budget to help us pay the amount that will be owed to DOT.

Mary has found a grant and we may be able to get 3 generator's 1 for each of the remaining pump stations and one for the town office.
