The Town used approximately 760 ton of the 800 ton of salt that was reserved by the State of Maine. The Town has asked for the same amount of 800 ton with the State of Maine with a 25% allowance to go over if needed for the 2023-2024 winter season.

Dirigo Engineering is handling the Bids for Paving on Ryder, Outer Bowman, Blaine and Littlefield Lane. The RFP is written with everything separated so that if the bid is too high parts of it may be removed easily without having to go back out to bid. The bids for this RFP are due back by 5/15/2023 and Doug will keep the Highway committee informed.
