

Dog Licensing Guidelines

If you are the owner of a dog(s) over 6 months of age, Or, after the dog has been with the family for 10 days, if adopted, you are obligated to license your dog(s) in the Farmingdale Town Office annually on or before January 31 in accordance to Title 7, MRSA, §3921 & §3943.

Please bring the following items to the Farmingdale Town Office:

- A copy of your Maine certification of Rabies vaccination to show current proof that your dog(s) has been immunized against rabies.
- Certification showing proof of spaying or neutering.

The fee to relicense a dog is \$6.00 for a spayed/neutered dog or \$11.00 for an unaltered dog. There is also a late fee of \$25.00 per dog after January 31st. The Town's Animal Control Officer will be following up with individuals who have not licensed their dog(s).

If you no longer own your dog(s), or the animal is deceased, please notify our office at 582-2225 so that we can update our records.

Dates To Remember

January - Check Vehicle Registration each month for expiration date.

Dog Licensing is required and due by January 1st of every year. After January 31st, a \$25.00 late fee per dog will be applied to unpaid licenses. See the "Dog Licenses Guidelines" section for more details.
