FRAC Committee Meeting Minutes

June 1, 2022

The Farmingdale Road Advisory Committee (FRAC) met on June 1, 2022 at 6:45pm.
Members Present: Eben Gilman (Chair), Robert Nitzel and Nancy Frost
Others Present: Doug Ebert (liaison), Gerald Staples

FRAC meeting was called to order

- ✚ Eben made a motion accept the minutes of 5/4/2022
- ✚ Nancy 2nd the motion
- ✚ Vote 3-0-0

The Select Board asked that McGee Construction come back with another figure after the following adjustments to the contract Winter Maintenance Contract:

1. No Liquid
2. Without computerized metering equipment the drivers will need to control the amount being dropped.
3. Changing the temperature before putting sand down on the roads
4. The amount of salt that McGee would be keeping on hand

Doug updated the committee with figures that came back from McGee construction

Original bid amount was \$2,033,000.00

Year one-655,000.00

Year two-680,000.00

Year three-698,000.00

After adjustments the bid came in at \$1,542,850.00 this is a savings of \$490,150.00

Year one-499,550.00

Year two-511,750.00

Year three-531,550.00

Currently the Town is in a bid process with the State of Maine to get a better price on salt, this will need to be discussed at a later time with McGee construction when the town finds out what the price will be.

- ✚ Eben recommended to approve bid price of \$1,542,850.00 from McGee construction and move forward to the Select Board.
- ✚ Nancy 2nd the motion
- ✚ Vote 3-0-0

Paving – 500,000.00 was put into the budget for an estimate to pave Adams Street, Blaine Road and three sections of Northern Ave.

Steve Stratton is working with Dirigo Engineering to get paving and ditching done in town

The committee would like to review the budget for the highway at the next meeting.
