Meeting opened by Jim Grant at 6:30 p.m. with Pledge of Allegiance.

Rose presented a Quit Claim deed for payment of Sewer that was paid after the automatic foreclosure date. The property was on Northern Avenue – Map 99 Lot 2.

Sewer Abatements were also signed in accordance to the sewer ordinance for request by residents with separate meters to calculate the flow of water used not entering the sewer system.

Discussion on having Pete Coughlan putting a survey on the web site regarding the Recreational Marijuana law, as to what direction that the residents would like to see the Town go with the current law. The Planning Board has asked if we could have something on the Web- Site. Nancy would like it understood that it is an informational survey only and non-binding. There will be hearings held before the Town Meeting and a vote at the Town Meeting regarding the municipal involvement of this law.

Jim Grant – That with Hallowell sharing a station with Farmingdale that perhaps there should be some automatic aid agreement. The Board will discuss this with the Fire Department about crafting an agreement. There will be two bid openings at the February 22 Selectboard meeting, for Northern Avenue and Hayford Heights.
