

Town of Farmingdale Select Board Minutes  
July 26, 2017

Members Present: James Grant – Nancy Frost - Wayne Kilgore--Others Present: Rose Webster – Cindy Burnham–Steve Stratton – Doug Ebert.

Meeting opened by Jim Grant at 6:30 p.m. with Pledge of Allegiance.

- Nancy Frost made a motion to accept the minutes of July 12, 2017
- Wayne Kilgore second
- Vote approved 3/0

The Selectboard reviewed the Commitment and reviewed different rates with what the overlay and mil rate would be. Cindy and Rose presented several different rates showing the differences on the commitment.

- Wayne Kilgore made a motion to approve the mil rate at 16.05.
- Nancy Frost second
- Vote approved 3/0

The commitment papers were signed by the Selectboard. Rose said that she would be working on getting the Tax Bills to the printers by the end of this week.

There was a discussion on the Cemetery Sexton position. The two people that had interviewed declined to pursue the position any further. Nancy Frost felt that we should just call Angie Ellis and see if she would consider taking the position again. It was decided to put it in the paper, on MMA website and our website for the next Selectboard meeting.

- Jim Grant made a motion to put the position back out for bid.
- Wayne Kilgore second
- Vote approved 2/1
- Nancy Frost was opposed

Steve Stratton – gave a report on areas that he has followed up on in the past few weeks. He is checking on the ditching that needs to be fixed on Bowman Street as there is pavement falling away. Steve has checked on several other culverts that are bad and he will work on prioritizing them, to get some contracts going. He will also check with the Gardiner Water District to see when the Blaine Road is going to be fixed.

Two Sewer abatements were reviewed by the Selectboard.

- Jim Grant made a motion to approve both Sewer Abatements
- Nancy Frost second
- Vote approved 3/0

Angie Ellis has asked to be allowed to place the corner markers for Roger Mallar that she had ordered and came in after her contract had ended. The Selectboard agreed that it would be okay for her to do that.

Michael Swett submitted an application for being on the Planning Board. The Selectboard asked that he come in the next meeting to meet with them. Doug Ebert was present to meet with the Selectboard regarding his application for the Sewer/FRAC Committee.

- Jim Grant made a motion to adjourn 7:47 and go into executive session for Personal Matters 1 M.R.S.A. §405(6) (A) for the Sewer/FRAC Committee. It was noted that the Selectboard would not be reconvening after the Executive Session would be made at the August 9th meeting.
