F.R.A.C. Meeting Minutes

November 7, 2018

The Farmingdale Road Advisory Committee (F.R.A.C.) met on Wednesday November 7, 2018 following the Farmingdale Sewer Committee meeting at the Farmingdale Town Office.

Members Present: Doug Ebert (Chair), Ken Martin, and Eben Gilman

Others Present: Nancy Frost (liaison) and Natalie Jackson (Secretary).

Doug called the meeting to order at the close of the Sewer Committee Meeting.

Minutes of 9/12/2018 and 10/10/2018 were reviewed by the FRAC committee.

- ‡ Doug Ebert made a motion to accept the minutes of 9/12/2018 as written and to accept the minutes of 10/10/2018 with one change to remove Jeff Ellis from attendees as he was not present for this meeting

40 Easy Street – 40 Easy Street was rejected by the Selectboard. Doug asked Nancy to explain the Select Boards decision in this matter. Nancy said that the Selectboard felt that the price to replace this culvert and ditch was too high. The Selectboard felt that if this was put out in the spring that they may get more than one bid and that the bids may be less. This will be tabled until the spring when this can be put out to bid.

Steve Stratton (Road Commissioner) has identified some trees on the Outlet Road as well as 945 Northern Ave. that need to be removed. The Selectboard has directed Steve to get quotes for these two jobs. Steve got a quote from Capital Tree for the Outlet Road in the amount of \$1,800.00 and a quote from Brownies in the amount of \$2,000.00. Steve also got a quote from Capital Tree for the 945 Northern Ave. in the amount of \$2,200.00 and a quote from Brownies in the amount of \$2,100.00.

The FRAC committee went over the Street Sweeping, Pavement Marking and Road Side Mowing Contracts. These will be put out in the spring of 2019 for the years 2019 through 2021.

There was a question about the crosswalk at Hall-Dale Manor and who would be paying for this to be installed and who would maintain it.

New Business


The FRAC committee will be working on a schedule to pave roads in Farmingdale. This year when paving a road the back Fire Station will be included in that to get the finish put on that parking lot.

Steve will ride around Hayford Heights to find out what roads would need to be brushed and a contract will be put together in the spring for this work to be done.




