The Select board approved and signed the Treasurer Warrants & Payroll Warrants #'s 36 & 37

Doug motioned to approved the February 28, 2024 minutes as written, Ike 2nd, all in favor

Started the meeting off with Charles Smith to discuss cleaning up his property on Maple St. We are receiving a lot of complaints about the garbage around his property. After much discussion on what needed to be done an agreement was made between Charles and the Select Board that he would have substantial cleanup done by April 10th. Greg will monitor the situation.

As requested, Natalie called Honey Badger for references. All though he has not done any local work yet -Gardiner, Hallowell and Randolph have already contracted with them.

Doug said after watching the presentation that Honey Badger gave this is exactly what the town needs.

ARPA funds will be used for the initial cost, and the annual maintenance fee will be paid with sewer funds.

Doug motioned to contract with Honey Badger to do the initial data collection which will be \$20,997.54, and adding GIS for \$5,450 & \$550 annually to maintain it, Ike 2nd, all in favor.

Paving Bids were discussed, Doug and Steve would like to get the advertisement out sooner than later.

Doug motioned to put the Paving Bids out and advertise on March 15, 16 and 17. The bids will be due back before the next select board meeting on April 10th, prior to 6:30pm. Ike 2nd, all in favor.

Coffin Engineering sent a request to Doug regarding Dwain Twomey wanting to subdivide his land at 540 Litchfield Rd. The planning board would like comments from the Select board in regards to the subdivision. Per Doug, as long as the subdivision is not going against any ordinances and meets all requirements the select board has no objections with the subdivision.

Adam St- repaired shoulder and will now have to pave it in
Dale St-flooded again because the cross pipe was plugged
Easy St- cross pipes will need to clean the up as well
