Eben called the Sewer Committee meeting to order on 6/5/2024.

Budget Item – The committee was made aware that we will need to replace the SCADA computer and we will be getting a quote for this from Maine Computer Service.

Vortex – The committee went over the May report and found no issues.

I&I Study – The Select Board agreed to collaborate with Gardiner Waste Water to have an RFP written up to see what work will need to be done to stop infiltration into Farmingdale’s sewer system causing the readings to be high. When the bids come in Gardiner will meet with Farmingdale to discuss what Farmingdale will need to do and what the cost will be for Farmingdale.

Dead River – Dead River has removed the four (4) 120-gallon tanks and replaced them with larger tanks on Northern Ave. and Bowman Street. There was no charge for this as this was part of the installation of the generators.

Kokernak Inspection Report – There were two (2) reports from Kokernak. They found that the block heater on Bowman was leaking and the block heater on Northern was dripping so they tightened the connection on both. Everything was checked and passed inspection.


